

SCCC Parent Information for childcare

***Currently, SCCC is only able to provide childcare for children aged 0-6 years. Once COVID restrictions lessen, we will re-evaluate childcare for older children at that time.*

COVID SAFETY: We'll all need to work together to help keep SCCC children safe, so please stay home if your child:

- Has had a fever in the past 14 days.
- Shows any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Has been around anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Has runny nose, cough, or cold/flu symptoms.

Arrival & Check-In

Children's Church is located in the church office building (2 buildings over from Community Theatre) and is open for child drop-off **no earlier than 9:45am**. Children will be checked-in by an SCCC volunteer at the door and escorted to their classroom. Due to COVID concerns and children's safety, we are trying to limit the number of people entering the building.

0-2 year olds: For babies and toddlers attending nursery, the parent/guardian can walk child to nursery room. Please label diaper bag with child's name and provide diapers, wipes, or any other necessities. We will also have you complete a brief form regarding your care preferences.

Snacks & Drinks

Due to COVID risks, we ask that **snacks NOT be sent** with babies/children; however, labeled bottles/drinks are permitted.

Pick-up

Immediately following service, please pick up your child. Only parent/guardian(s) listed on the child's registration form will be permitted to pick up children.

Health & Safety

SCCC staff and volunteers are committed to providing children a clean and safe environment to learn and play. Due to COVID, children aged 3 and up will be required to wear a mask that cover their mouth and nose. Upon entry, children will wash hands and hand sanitizer will be used throughout children's church. High frequency touch areas will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized and we will work to social distance children as much as possible.

Each volunteer working with your child has:

- Completed an application
- Conducted interviews with church staff
- Provided character references that were directly contacted by church staff
- Passed a background check
- Attended training
