Matthew 28:18-20 (NLT)

¹⁸ Jesus came and told his disciples, “I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth.

¹⁹ Therefore, **go and make disciples** of all the nations, **baptizing** them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

²⁰ **Teach** these new disciples **to obey all the commands I have given you**. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”

What is the Vision of SCCC?

The vision of SCCC is that every person would experience a transforming life through faith in Jesus Christ.

(Romans 12: 1-2)

Romans 12:1-2 (NLT)

¹ And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.

² Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Romans 8:5-8 (NLT)

- ⁵ Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit.
- ⁶ So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace.
- ⁷ For the sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God's laws, and it never will.
- ⁸ That's why those who are still under the control of their sinful nature can never please God.

1 Samuel 15:22-23 (NLT)

²² But Samuel replied, “What is more pleasing to the LORD: your burnt offerings and sacrifices or your obedience to his voice? Listen! Obedience is better than sacrifice, and submission is better than offering the fat of rams.

²³ Rebellion is as sinful as witchcraft, and stubbornness as bad as worshiping idols. So because you have rejected the command of the LORD, he has rejected you as king.”

What is the Mission of SCCC?

The mission of SCCC is to demonstrate God's transforming work through loving God wholeheartedly, loving others genuinely and serving our world generously.

(Matthew 22: 37-40)

Matthew 22:37-40 (NLT)

- ³⁷ Jesus replied, “You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.’
- ³⁸ This is the first and greatest commandment.
- ³⁹ A second is equally important: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’
- ⁴⁰ The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments.”

1 Peter 2:11-12 (NLT)

¹¹ Dear friends, I warn you as “temporary residents and foreigners” to keep away from worldly desires that wage war against your very souls.

¹² Be careful to live properly among your unbelieving neighbors. Then even if they accuse you of doing wrong, they will see your honorable behavior, and they will give honor to God when he judges the world.

1. **Spiritual** (relationship with God)
2. **Relational** (relationship with others)
3. **Financial** (support God's work, private/corp.)
4. **Physical** (honoring God's temple)
5. **Behavioral** (spiritual disciplines)
6. **Vocational** (taking God to work)
7. **Intellectual** (Christian worldview)

Focusing our Calling

1 John 4:7-13 (NKJV)

⁷ Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.

⁸ He who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

⁹ In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.

¹⁰ In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.

¹¹ Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

¹² No one has seen God at any time. If we love one another, God abides in us, and His love has been perfected in us.

¹³ By this we know that we abide in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit.
